Category B 'Health and Wellbeing'

The Combined Grants Program is funded by the Community Support Levy. The levy is derived from profits of gaming machines in hotels and clubs and held by Trust in the Department of Treasury and Finance. The Grants are administered through the Gambling Support Program within the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS).

Health and Wellbeing Grants provide up to \$100,000 for innovative programs that address the causes of lowered health outcomes, social exclusion and unhealthy behaviours. Funding preference is for organisations which can provide community based health and social programs for areas significantly affected by electronic gaming machine gambling.

Funding preference is for organisations, perhaps in partnership, who can provide strategic community development in lower socio-economic communities. At a concept proposal level two applications have been shortlisted as potential recipients. DHHS staff will work with these applicants to develop a full submission for funding.
