New Community Housing Suburbs

We are making improvements to social housing in Tasmania.

Community housing providers manage around 4 000 public housing properties in Tasmania.

Another 2 000 properties will be transferred to community housing management in 2021.

Do you live in a participating suburb?

Find out more....

If you live in a participating suburb, you should know:

- The way your rent is calculated will not change. The organisation you pay your rent to will change.
- A community housing provider will manage your lease.
- Your lease with Housing Tasmania will not change unless you want it to.
- You can choose to sign a lease with the community housing provider in your area.
- Community housing providers have their own tenancy and maintenance services.
- You will get their contact information when they begin managing your tenancy in the second half of 2021.
